্ঠি What Services Will Be Affected?

- Our branch network will close by 5 p.m. on Friday, September 16, and remain closed on Saturday, September 17. Extended phone service will be available. Call us at (518) 793-4121.
- Many digital services will be unavailable during the weekend. That includes Internet and Mobile Banking and Business Online Banking.
- ATM and debit card usage may be briefly interrupted.
- Account balances may not reflect pending transactions during the weekend.

On-Call Banking will be unavailable during the upgrade.
 Active users will need to re-enroll beginning Monday, September 19.



What Should I Do to Prepare?

- In case debit card service is briefly interrupted, make sure to have an alternate form of payment ready during the upgrade weekend.
